

CSCC Solo Committee Monthly Meeting
March 15, 2006

Meeting called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Chairman, Art Rinner.

Roll Call: CASOC, No Bucks, SCNAX, PSCC, Team Blew, PFM, GRA, SVTOA, M+4
Quorum Present. Morgan +4, TCC not present.

Secretary's Report: **Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Unanimously approved.**

Treasurer's Report: Craig Angel presented February's treasurer's report. Craig reminded CASOC that they still owe team dues. Amount is now \$35.00. Craig also reported that he has received the Title to the Motorhome from the Bank. It is now totally paid off. Craig announced that he will be attending the Probate Trial on 4/16/06.

Pro Solo: Brief discussion about pumping out Johns during the weekend, as well as the placement of the Johns.

Points: Gio questioned points card members for TCC. Lengthy discussion followed Art to post message on message board.

Old Business: Bill Schenker discussed the Division's interest in putting on a Divisional. Las Vegas has no interest and it looks like it would probably be a San Diego/CSCC Event. Therefore, it was decided not to pursue Divisional for this year. Glenn Duensing to bring it up to the Division as a possible Divisional Series for 2007. Suggestion was made that we get the information into the SoPac News and Sports Car Magazine.

Craig Angel requested the use of the Motorhome for Lone Pine Time Trials at no cost. He informed the Committee that Lone Pine was a charitable event and that all proceeds from the event are donated to the Braille Institute. **Motion made and seconded to allow the Lone Pine Time Trials to use the Motorhome at no cost. Motion carried.**

FSAE West Event: Ian Stewart introduced Dean Case & Joni Gang who have been contracted to organize the event. The Committee consists of: Art Rinner, Ian Stewart, Rick Brown, Renee Angel & Bob Beamesderfer. It was suggested that a separate FSAE forums be added to the Solo 2 website for discussion between committee members & volunteers. Ian stressed that he would like all Club Reps to solicit volunteers from their clubs. The event is scheduled for June 16th – June 17th; Friday, June 16th is the main event. Afternoon Tech is scheduled for June 14th – June 15th. Lengthy discussion followed regarding volunteers for the event.

Renee Angel announced that she has recently obtained a Solo Safety Steward Instructor license and would like to schedule a Safety Steward School sometime this year. Date for Safety Steward School to be coordinated with our Solo 2 calendar. She asked that all club members who are interested in becoming a Safety Steward, e-mail her.

Discussion followed regarding purchasing new cones. It was pointed out that the cones that were recently purchase for the Pro Solo were defective, too heavy and that the bases are getting stiffer. Suggestion was made that we try using smaller cones. **Motion made and seconded that we get rid of all current cones, use the new cones recently purchased for Pro Solo only and purchase shorter cones (12"). Motion carried with No \$ abstaining.**
